

# USHERS MINISTRY TEAM



There are two teams of ushers at Woodmont Baptist Church (WBC). Each team serves alternating months so that a team serves a total of 6 months each year. For special events, ushers are drawn from both teams. WBC ushers serve for both the morning and evening services during their assigned months. Ushers are often the first person to see members and visitors as they arrive for worship. The ministry of ushering is one of the most visible ministries at WBC.

The role of usher is a volunteer position.

Some duties of WBC ushers are listed below:

- Making everyone, members and visitors, feel welcome at each service – exhibiting God's love and WBC's love to each person
- Escorting members and guest to an empty seat when the church is full or when seating is limited
- Handing out bulletins at the entrances to the sanctuary
- Assisting people with special needs
- Helping visitors find their way around the church: to the children's area, restrooms, elevators or assisting them with any other need
- Collect tithes and offerings
- By partnering with the Security Ministry Team, ushers are responsible for maintaining order and security in each service

The heart of an usher is the heart of a SERVANT and does his work for his Lord Jesus. The theme verse for an usher could very well be Psalm 84:10. "Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a door keeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked."
